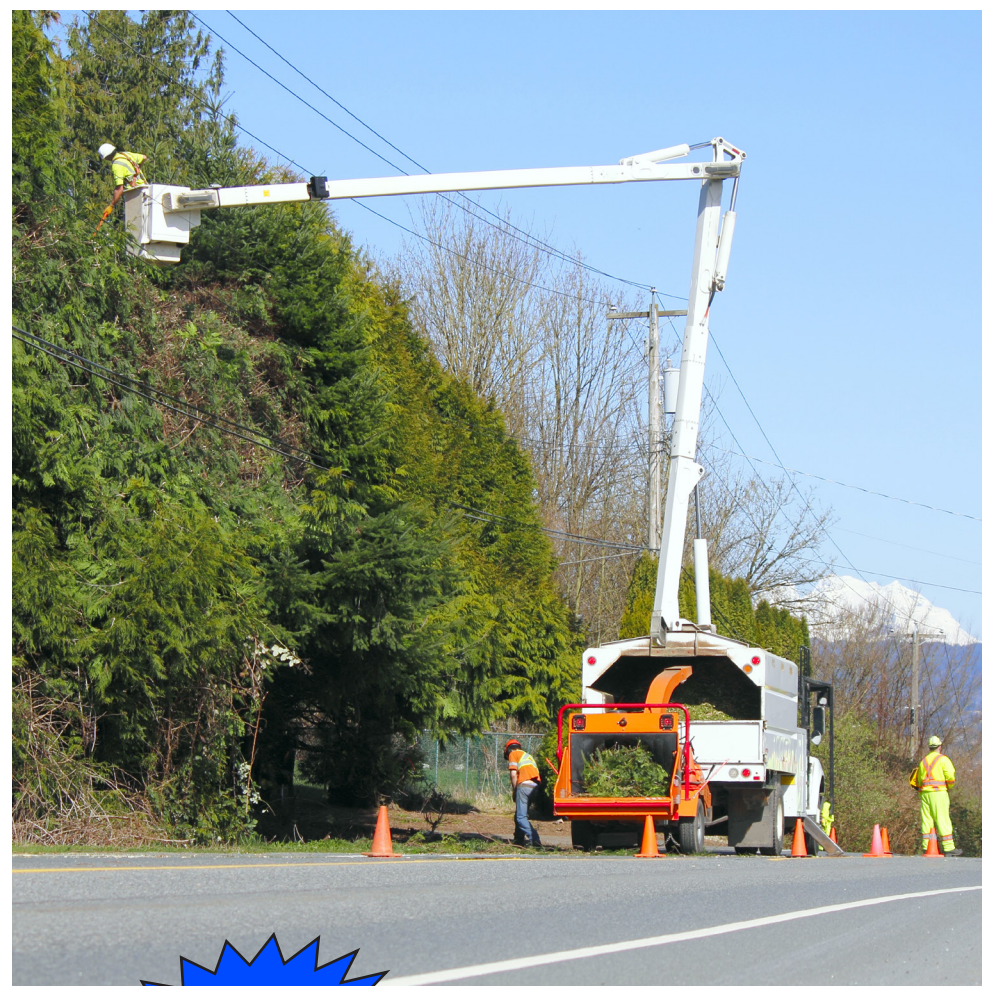

Utility Tree Worker / Trimmer Re-Certification

for the Professional Vegetation Managers Association

The Professional Vegetation Managers Association, in association with the Work and Safety Standards Division of Alberta Labour requires Certified Utility Tree Trimmers and Utility Tree Workers to complete a recertification course within five years of the original course date and every five years thereafter.

In this two day, in-class course you will be updated on current electrical safety standards and safety practices important to you on the job.

After successful completion of this course and having received a passing mark on the exam, currently-employed Utility Tree Workers and Utility Tree Trimmers can apply to the PVMA for recertification.

Pre-Requisite:

Previous Utility Tree Worker or Utility Tree Trimmer Certification.

Note: All questions related to the Utility Tree Worker / Trimmer courses may be directed to Olds College. All questions related to your Utility Tree Worker / Trimmer certification and/or recertification, are to be directed to the PVMA.
